Only Andy attended and no apologies were made on behalf of SCAA.

The coaching committee via Richard Jones should have submitted their budget for 2005/2006 but had not done so. GWAS council considered this to be impolite and advised that they would grant no funds until further notice. The council also suggested that the coaching committee reconsider its representative. The GWAS subscription should have been increased as voted for at the AGM, however the incorrect amount has been recorded and the vote therefore becomes null and void. There will be no increase for this affiliation year.

Great concern has been expressed over the activities of the EAF. GWAS council received no replies to communication and believe EAF have carried out some unconstitutional activities. GWAS have therefore decided to withdraw the subscription (50p per archer) currently made to EAF.
