

## SCAA – TREASURERS REPORT FOR 2004 AGM

- 1 Firstly, apologies for my absence – the sunny climes of work in Manchester proved too strong to resist ! (or was it the lure of the Trafford Shopping Centre ?)
- 2 Income has increased for the 2003 year over the 2002 year quite substantially. This is made up of several factors, namely increased income from affiliations following the increase in the rates for last year (from vv to bb, an increase of some £445), increased profits from all the Tournaments (up by XX from ZZ to YY) and decreased expenditure. In particular we did not make any bursaries in 2003 nor did we buy or replat any trophies.
- 3 We should not be complacent however about the County's finances as in 2004 we will need to purchase a new batch of medals. I intend to buy at least a 5 year supply and this will of course take up all the extra income generated in 2003.
- 4 Despite the bank stating in mid summer 2003 that they would no longer give us bank interest on our savings account, they have continued to do so. I intend to keep quiet & accept it !
- 5 Finally a continued plea for all club treasurers to continue their good work with the affiliation sheets. These have improved over the past year, reducing the time taken to process them. Please keep this up !
